

Mission Statement Worksheet

Mission Statement: the reason your organization exists - answering WHAT, WHO, and WHERE

Your Current Mission Statement:

Questions to Discuss:

What key words or phrases clearly describe the reason your organization exists? (think of NOUNS)

What kind of actionable words describe the work you do? (think of VERBS)

What makes your work unique, relevant, or distinguished? (think of ADJECTIVES)

Write Them Out:

Using the words and phrases generated above, draft a few versions of a new or refined mission statement for your organization.

Review Your Mission:

Once you have a final draft, use the questions below to review and assess your mission statement.

- Does it clearly connect with the values your organization?
- Does it allow for flexibility of work within your issue area?
- It is as succinct and short enough for people to remember and repeat (memorable)?
- Does it provide direction and help us make decisions about our work?
- Does it compel someone to fund or otherwise support your work?

Guidelines:

- Simple and concrete language
- Middle school reading level
- Avoid buzz words / jargon
- 20 words or less (or 1 sentence)
- No more than 1 word string (A, B, and C)
